An exceptional public park with golf, volleyball, tennis, basketball, softball, kayaking, fishing, picnic areas, grills, covered pavilions, hike-and-bike path along the river, fitness trail, kids playscapes, wave pool, and fenced-in Barky Park for dogs.



### WALNUT SPRINGS PARK

Wildlife, bird-watching, local flora, walkways, bridges, historic marker, and memorial rose garden path.



### CENTRAL PARK

201 S. Austin St. in the town square. Historic monuments and markers, bandstand, art-deco fountain, benches, walkways, special events.

## ★ Walking/Running

### PECAN BOTTOM FITNESS TRAIL

Walk or jog this .8 mile trail through a shaded pecan grove. Dogs on leash allowed. In Max Starcke Park East.



### TLU FITNESS TRAIL

Walk or jog on this .6 mile fitness trail around TLU's sports complex. Dogs on leash allowed but please pick up after them. Off Hwy 90 at Fleming Dr. on campus.



### PARK WEST

Fitness trail that connects with the Library and Max Starcke Park, nature trails.

### 5K RUNS/WALKS

Each year during ArtsFest in March is the Color Me Nutty Fun Run. Other runs/walks for good causes take place throughout the year.



## ★ Biking

### TOUR DE PECAN

Each October during Pecan Fest, bikers come from all over to ride in this event that benefits Wounded Warriors.



### TRAILS

There are plenty of bike trails in town from the Irma Lewis Outdoor Learning Center to the Pecan Bottom Trail to the biking trail that runs from Park West to Max Starcke Park. Also, try the new off-road bike trail at Park West.



## ★ Water Sports

### WATER SPORTS ON THE GUADALUPE RIVER

Enjoy boat ramps, fishing areas, paddling trails, tubing, RV parks, and picnic areas.

### PADDLING TRAILS

Lake Seguin Paddling Trail at Max Starcke Park: 4 miles.  
Seguin Paddling Trail at Lake Nolte Meadow Lake: 2-8 miles.



### TUBING

Rent some tubes at the Power Plant Texas Grill on South Austin St. just south of Max Starcke Park on the river.

### LAKES

Lakes with public boating, paddling, skiing and fishing for catfish, spotted bass, crappie, sunfish, and largemouth bass.

**Lake Placid** - exit 605 off I-10 under the bridge. Boat ramp and public parking.

**Lake Seguin** - S. Austin St. in Max Starcke Park. 4-mile paddling trail, fishing.

**Meadow Lake** - boating, fishing, paddling trails from 2.6 to 8.4 miles from Max Starcke Park East, River Shade RV Park or Nolte Dam.



## ★ Birding

Grab your binoculars and find a spot at one of our fine parks to scope out the various birds in the area including red-tailed hawks, cardinals, golden-cheeked warblers, cranes, herons, and you might even spot a golden eagle.

## ★ Skateboarding

Skaters will love the new Michael T. Raetzsch (MTR) Skatepark at Park West with its new modern design. A great way to "keep Seguin rolling."



## ★ Golf Courses

Open daily. This top-ranked 18-hole course winds along the river lined with mature pecan trees. Cart rental, pro shop, and practice tees.



## ★ Wave Pool

### MAX STARCKE PARK WAVE POOL

Open Tues-Sun, Memorial weekend through August. Freshwater surf with four wave patterns, splash pool, tubes, water aerobics, lessons, picnic tables, and snack bar.



## ★ Dog Park

**BARKY PARK** - at Max Starcke Park on the west side off S. Austin St. Separate fenced areas for small and large dogs. Waste bags, water for dogs, and some benches. Lots of shade from the giant pecan trees and lots of space to run, fetch and play.



## ★ Playgrounds

Max Starcke Park East has new play structures with lots of shade, picnic areas and grills. Manuel C. Castilla Park and Park West also have playscapes for the kids.
