archive and leadership library dedicated to the Presidency.

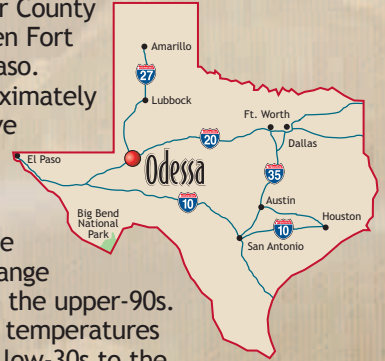
Odessa is the home of champion athletes such as Olympic Silver Medalist Toby Stevenson and NFL greats Roy Williams, Marcus Cannon and Bront Bird. We're proud of all the achievements of our sports teams. In fact, Odessa was the setting for both the national best-selling book and feature film "Friday Night Lights."

Odessa is located in the geographic region known as the Permian Basin, where the discovery of oil in 1926 propelled the city into an enviable position. Odessa quickly became the service, workforce, transportation, supply and manufacturing center of the Permian Basin. It remains so today, and is considered one of the major oil field technology centers in the world.



Odessa at a Glance

- Odessa is the 30th largest city in Texas, with a population of 99,940.
- Located in Ector County midway between Fort Worth and El Paso.
- Odessa is approximately 2,851 feet above sea level.
- Climate is mild and semi-arid. Summer average temperatures range from the 60s to the upper-90s. Winter average temperatures range from the low-30s to the upper-50s.



Getting to Odessa

BY AIR - Midland International Airport (432/560-2200) is located approximately

halfway between Odessa and Midland. Air service is provided by American Eagle, Continental Airlines, Southwest Airlines, and United Express. Odessa's Schlemeyer Field caters to privately-owned aircraft.

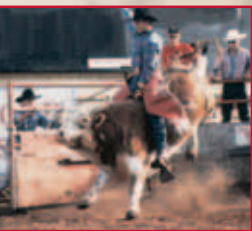

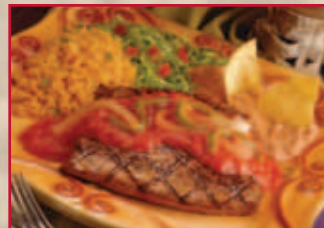

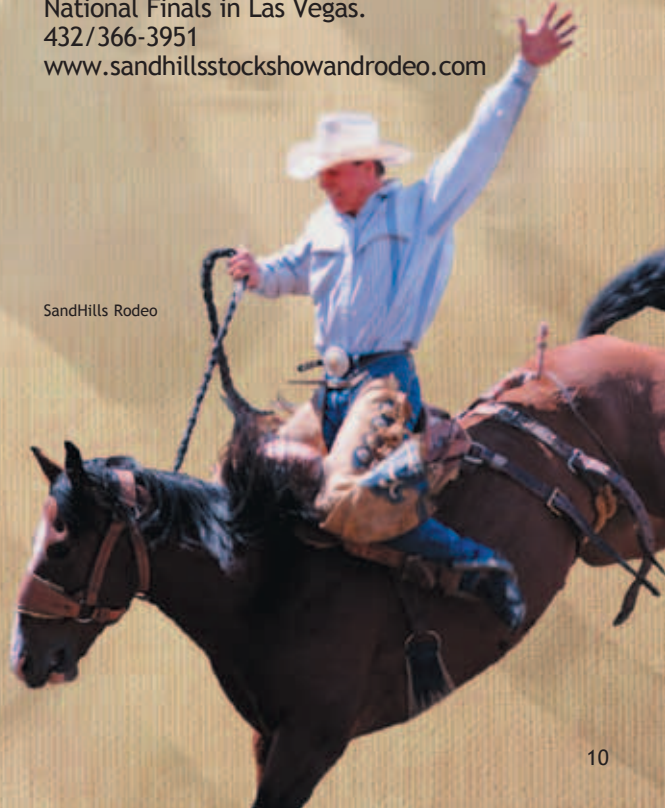

Walking Trails

Memorial Garden Park - 42nd and JBS Parkway. Dedicated to the original pioneer families that settled this area. The brand of each ranch and brief history are permanently displayed, and sculptures of native animals and people surround this calming playa lake that includes a 9/10-mile trail.

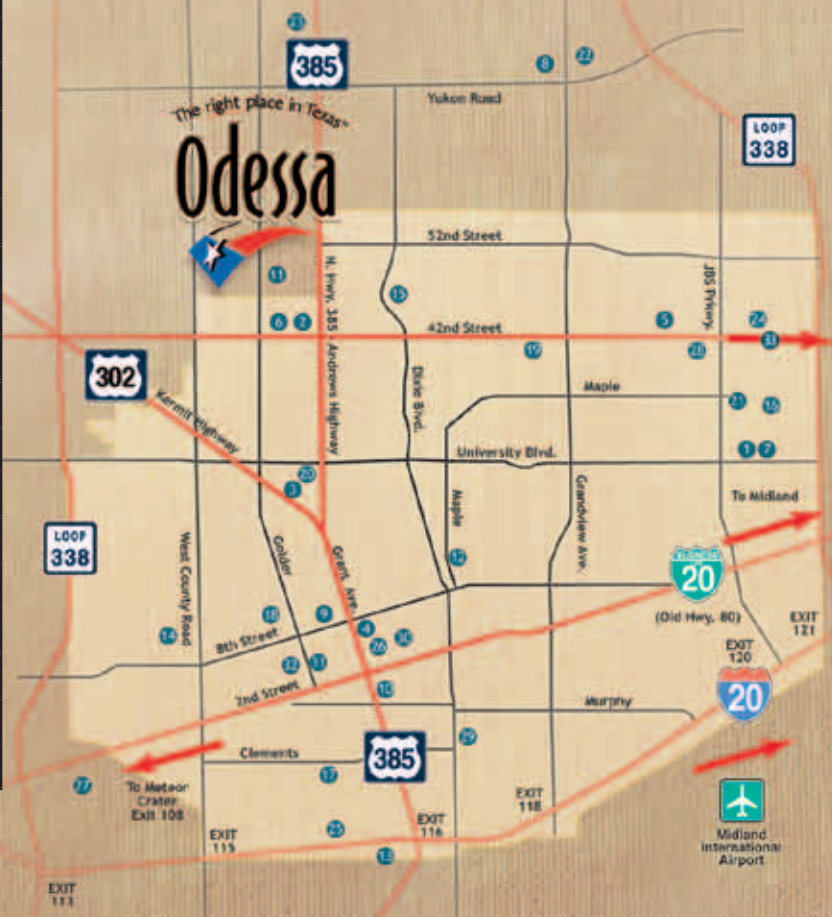
