REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The following document details the requirements to submit a bid to host the United States Collegiate Athletic Association's National Convention, which will capture approximately 200 room nights plus an additional \$30K in master billing. The RFP is open to member institutions, qualifying cities, CVB's and sports commissions.





REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Intent to Bid: Due December 1, 2026 Official Proposal: Due January 31, 2027 Site Announcement: March 1, 2027

The United States Collegiate Athletic Association was formed in 2001, as a reformation of the National Small College Athletic Association, which dates back to 1966. The association continues the mission of providing opportunities for small colleges across the United States to compete against like institutions for National Championships and student-athlete recognition.

Since 2006, the USCAA has grown from 42 member institutions to nearly 80 in 2024. Each year, the association hosts seventeen championship events in Golf, Men's Soccer (D1 & D2), Women's Soccer (D1 & D2), Volleyball (D1 & D2), Men's Cross Country, Women's Cross Country, Men's Basketball (D1 & D2), Women's Basketball (D1 & D2), Basketball, Men's & Women's Track and Field, Softball, & Baseball. More than 70% of USCAA member institutions that were eligible qualified to compete in one or more USCAA National Championship in 2023-24.

Headquartered in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the USCAA maintains a full-time staff of three persons with additional support provided from contractors, part-time employees, graduate assistants, interns, and volunteers.



ANNUAL CONVENTION OVERVIEW

EVENT BACKGROUND

The USCAA National Convention is an annual meeting of USCAA Athletic Directors, administrators, and coaches. The event includes Town Hall sessions on championships, ratings/selections and bylaws, business meetings, as well as professional development and social opportunities. Members are highly encouraged to send at least one representative.

Previous host cities have been Pittsburgh, PA, Richmond, VA, Virginia Beach, VA, Norfolk, VA, Portland, ME and Winston-Salem, NC. The USCAA is open to any metropolitan area with convenient airport access east of the Mississippi River.

For 2028 and 2031 we are looking for a city located in the North East.
